

HOURS, HOURS, AND MORE HOURS!

One project can count towards more than one type of hour!

Examples: DLSSP earns service, district, interclub, and service initiative hours
Kiwanis Family Conference earns Kiwanis Family, social, interclub and international hours.

Social

Hours spent participating in an event that brings Circle Kers, or other Kiwanis Family members, together for the sole purpose of fellowship.

Service

A service hour is a voluntary act that benefits an individual or organization that possesses a need for the service. The project must be organized or promoted through the CKI club for hours to count. **Time of travel** to and from the service project and **preparation time** are also count towards service hours.

Kiwanis Family

Hours spent at an event or service project that has people from other levels of the Kiwanis Family attend, such as Key Club or Kiwanis (e.g. Kiwanis Family Conference).

Interclub

Hours spent on a fundraiser, social or service project with at least one other **Kiwanis Family** club. District and International events can also be counted as interclubs. For a project to count as an interclub, a certain number of members must attend from each club:

At least 2 members from a club of less than 20 members

At least 3 members from a club of 20-30 members

At least 4 members from a club of 30+ members

Administrative

Hours spent working on behalf of your club; this includes planning and fundraising for your own club, filling out monthly reports, board meetings, communication with organizations where you are not planning a specific project, ect.

Service Initiative

Hours spent on a project that is geared toward the CKI Service Initiative, to educate all CKI members about the problems and issues that face **children** worldwide, ages 6-13. This includes any project that involves bettering the lives of children.

International Event

Hours spent at an event that invites Circle K members from all over the world (ie. LSSP, ICON, Kiwanis Family Conference, Y'all).

Fundraising

Hours spent planning and fundraising for other organizations (i.e. not your own club).

Tomorrow Fund Fundraising

The amount of money raised for the Tomorrow Fund, a grant financially supported by CKI, given to clubs and districts for service projects.

District Event

Hours spent at an event hosted by the Carolinas District (e.g. DLSSP, Fall Rally, DCON)
