## May I Run and What Offices Are Open For Candidacy?

Any member of the Carolinas District of Circle K in good standing may serve as a candidate for the following at the Carolinas District's annual District Convention (DCON):

- Governor
- District Treasurer
- District Bulletin Editor
- District Secretary
- Lieutenant Governor
- International Endorsement

Position descriptions may be found in the District Bylaws and Policy Codes. Those interested in running should discuss the position with the incumbent.

## How Do I Declare My Candidacy?

Here is a checklist for candidates:

1. Complete the candidate form, which will include an application, Letter of Intent, and a service agreement.
2. Be nominated at the Opening Session of District Convention and be there to accept the nomination
3. Attend the Candidates & Delegates Session at DCON
4. Caucus at both Caucus Sessions during DCON
5. Attend the House of Delegates at DCON

## What Are Some Tips For Candidates?

- Create a coherent platform for your campaign
- Create literature to hand out during Caucus Sessions. Be sure to include your platform, experience, and other pertinent information
- Find a campaign team (non-delegate(s) and non-District Board members) to introduce you during the Caucus Sessions
- Ask your home club for an endorsement. Your home club is the only one that can endorse you. An endorsement simply means your club approves your candidacy; it does not guarantee a vote. Unanimous endorsements may only be publicized if 100% of the votes at your club meeting approved of for your endorsement.

## Restrictions:

- No campaigning outside of your home club sixty (60) days prior to DCON
- No travel for the sake of campaigning is permitted
- A Letter of Intent may only be sent to the District Board and club presidents. Additional contact is allowed if directly requested.
