Meeting commenced at 7:05pm

- Tyler began the pledge
- Sam did the attendance, see above
- Tyler then went into an icebreaker
 - Halloween icebreaker
 - Everyone talked about what they were going to be for Halloween
- Tyler went into opening updates:
 - Club vision boards reminder
 - DIVA checkpoint podcast
 - All episodes of season one are released
 - Tyler went over promoting the organization through the DIVA checkpoint podcast
 - ICON fundraisers
- Tyler talked about the membership benefit of the month:
 - Global leadership certificate
 - Learn through videos, resources, and activities at your own pace

- Access 40+ different courses on leadership, inclusion, civic engagement and change-making
 - Build skills in emotional intelligence, empathy, and resilience
 - Aligned with CKI's core values: service, leadership, etc.
- New this month
- Round of applause for Methodist's charter
 - First official charter of the service year
- Day of Service recap:
 - Week ago on October 18th
 - Lexington and Kamp Kiwanis, did renovations there
 - Evening at the HPU pageant, 4th annual
 - Raised over \$31,000 for UNICEF Brick x Brick
- Sadie went over Fall Call details:
 - Encouraging clubs to register, 15 spots left
 - Make sure members are aware that we are taking late registrations
 - Would love to have as many people and clubs as possible
- Sadie talked about DCON, February in Charlotte
 - Registration open and closes on the 16th
 - We want 50 people
 - Start getting conversations going with engagement and attendance
 - This price includes hotel and 3 meals
- Tyler talked about Bylaw Amendments
 - Any club in good standing attending DCON can put a bylaw forward for a vote
 - Due to Tyler by December 1st
- Sam talked about everything dues and CMRs
 - Tyler said that some can be processed now, and then some later
- Ms. Jen talked about the tomorrow fund grant due December 1st
 - Apply for \$200-\$2000 grants to fund impactful service projects
 - Winter application window: October 1 to December 1, 2025
 - Make sure club is in good standing and then go ahead and apply
- Tyler talked about the first year ambassador district chair
 - Any first year members are welcome to apply to this position
 - More of an entry level board position, experience interacting with our board but more with first-year ambassador chairs
- Amelia started with board books:
 - Going to be doing joint fundraising opportunity with another club
 - They have had good retention, focusing on paying dues now
- Alia talked for ECU:
 - Recruiting, getting dues and early birds in, she would like to highlight her VP hosting a networking event and called it Lead for Success, she said it was a success
- Will from Central:

- October has been a pretty good month, a lot of service events, game night with assisted living facility tomorrow night, partnership with NC State for the setup of the haunted house
- NC State, Cate:
 - Haunted house Friday went great, Key family event was great, also hoping to get more people to go to the Kiwanis meeting late in November, solid group of new members who have continued to return, still trying to get some dues in
- UNC, Caroline:
 - Board intros at last GBM, made 53 dog toys - shipped off to Florida, getting schedules together for upcoming GBM Tuesday to make sure everyone is clear with their roles in the club, sec and tres going to make document with all of service hours/dues paid/etc., treasurer able to apply to supplemental undergrad Senate funds
- USC, Jordan
 - Membership up to 9, have slowed down a bit in October, excited for November
- Tyler went over district goals update:
 - Actual reported member count is 230, goal is 260, almost there (88% there)
 - Important to get service hours collected to show off how our district is doing
 - Keep pushing through

- Update on the State of CKI:
 - CKI will keep its current structure while focusing on cost reduction and long-term sustainability
 - Cut spending by \$92,000
- Ms. Jen said that CKI grew this year as an organization, most charters across entire organization since 2017
 - Almost 40 charters across the country and all of CKI
 - Big thing for us is growth, where we will be able to help in reducing some deficit with trying to close in
