- Tyler went through opening updates, pledge, agenda, summer LeadCon
- Opening updates with the MUC, if help needed then contact Sam or Tyler
- Icebreaker with mood meter, energy and feeling meter
 - Everyone went through their moods and talked about how they've been over the past weekend and week
- William with NC A&T shared that he met through an e-board meeting with new board
- Consensus is a lot of us are feeling good but tired on the mood meter
- Kris went and shared information about International Convention and the recap
 - ICON awards, a list of awards within the district (lots) and we were the distinguished district.
 - District got to meet a bunch of other people, got a lot of people to follow the Carolinas district Instagram
- Tyler talked about getting interest from clubs and blocking out schedules for next year's ICON next summer
- Sadie went into Fall Call
 - Lillington, NC at Coble Water Ski School
 - November 7-9
 - Registration closes October 7th
 - Goal is to have 50 people to attend
 - Help spread information about dates and make sure to tell people it'll be a great weekend
- Sadie then showed a teaser for the theme of Fall Call

- Sam went into the Fundraising slide, talked about Brick x Brick, offering fundraising ideas, having people talk about successful fundraising in the past and potential new ideas for fundraising.
- Ideas about Fundraising that were talked about in a breakout room:
- Potential fundraising ideas that were talked about in breakout room 1:
 - Car wash
 - Football concessions, members can get hours
 - Different stands in the stadium to get food and one of them is run by an organization similar to Kiwanis
 - Business frat: reach out to freshmen in mid August - if you donate \$20, helps people move in
 - Helps with recruiting
 - Valentine's Day bake sale:
 - E-board people baked treats

 - Starting in July

- Angel talked about Day of Service Initiative:
 - October 18, 2025
 - 9am-1pm
 - Kamp Kiwanis, Lexington, NC
 - District-wide service event where CKI members join Kiwanis to improve Kamp Kiwanis through hands-on projects
 - Build community and strengthen Kiwanis partnership to make a lasting impact
 - Last year we helped to break down old cabins to prepare for safer new ones for kids
- Angel went into the Carolinas CKI Club Hours Tracking Tool
 - Goal of 24 hours per member for the whole year

- Have the Carolinas CKI service hours spreadsheet to log all the hours

- International initiative - a "day" of service every year
- We are either hitting this goal or hitting it out of the park

- NC Central:

- New business:
